In the following terms:

The two parts recognize bilaterally the important role played in society, through the promotion of values and quality of a system, through which a superior quality of professional relations is envisioned, through the protection of individual as well as group interests. The two parts provide the members of society with programs of civil support based on modern social solutions, transparent and European, viable from an economic point of view, original from a cultural point of view and accessible from the point of view of communication. Last but not least, InfoCons - through its programs and collaborators wants to be actively involved in society in such a way that will lead to effective consumer protection as well as well informed consumers with a view for Romania to meet the standards required by the European Union.

Taking into consideration the above facts, the two parts have decided:

1. OBJECTIVE:

- 1.1 The two parts shall promote themselves reciprocally, as well as develop Programs and activities with strong social implications.
- 1.2 The creation of common projects through cross border collaboration.



1.3 Reciprocal invitations and counseling in all areas of the field of consumer's protection

2. OBLIGATIONS OF THE TWO PARTS:

2.1 To promote reciprocally their image and actions within the field of activities that they undertake and which show interdependency with the activities developed by the other part.

2.2. To undertake common programs, which will be part of separate accords, in the fields that they represent, giving each other reciprocal support in the development and implementation of programs thus created.

2.3 Not to affect in any way, directly or indirectly the image of InfoCons, and not to bring injustices to the programs or actions which will be developed under common agreement, as well as the programs or actions undertaken by the other part.

2.4 The PARTNER will promote at the level of its members and employees as well as to its collaborators and to the member states of the European Union the programs developed by InfoCons

2.5 The PARTNER will be involve in the European Global Mobility Project (www.consumers-protection.org) for transparent access of citizens to emergency / useful numbers in each country. The first international initiative to unify access to information in the context of global digitization.

3. MODALITIES TO ACHIEVE THE OBJECTIVES:

3.1 The PARTNER can use the seal of InfoCons in the documents created within the framework of the programs undertaken, mentioning at the same time that the program is taking part under the auspices of InfoCons .

3.2 The two parts will create common channels of information and for the promotion of programs and activities that they undertake.

3.3 At the same time, the two parts will organize seminars, exhibitions, conferences on the purpose of implementation of programs undertaken by the two parts, as well as of the image of such programs at the level of the whole society.

4. OTHER CLAUSES:

4.1 Additional documents, which will later be created between the two parts, will complement this protocol.

4.2 The present document will no longer produce juridical effects, through a written agreement between the two parts.



4.3 Any modification of the present Protocol can take place only with the agreement of both parts, and should later be made into an additional document.

The present Protocol is concluded today, 28.03.2023 for an undetermined period, starting with the date of its signature, in two copies, one for each part.
